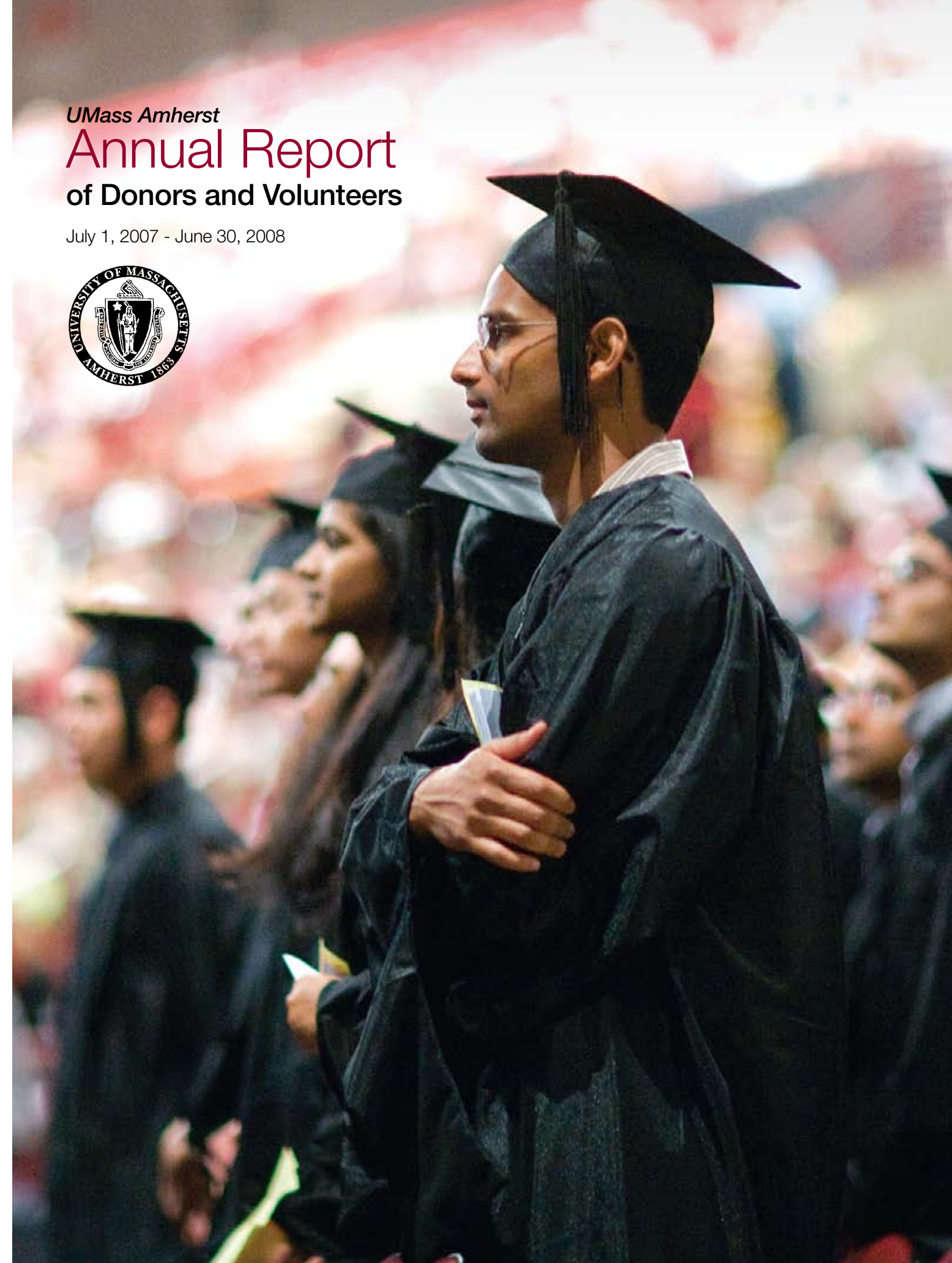

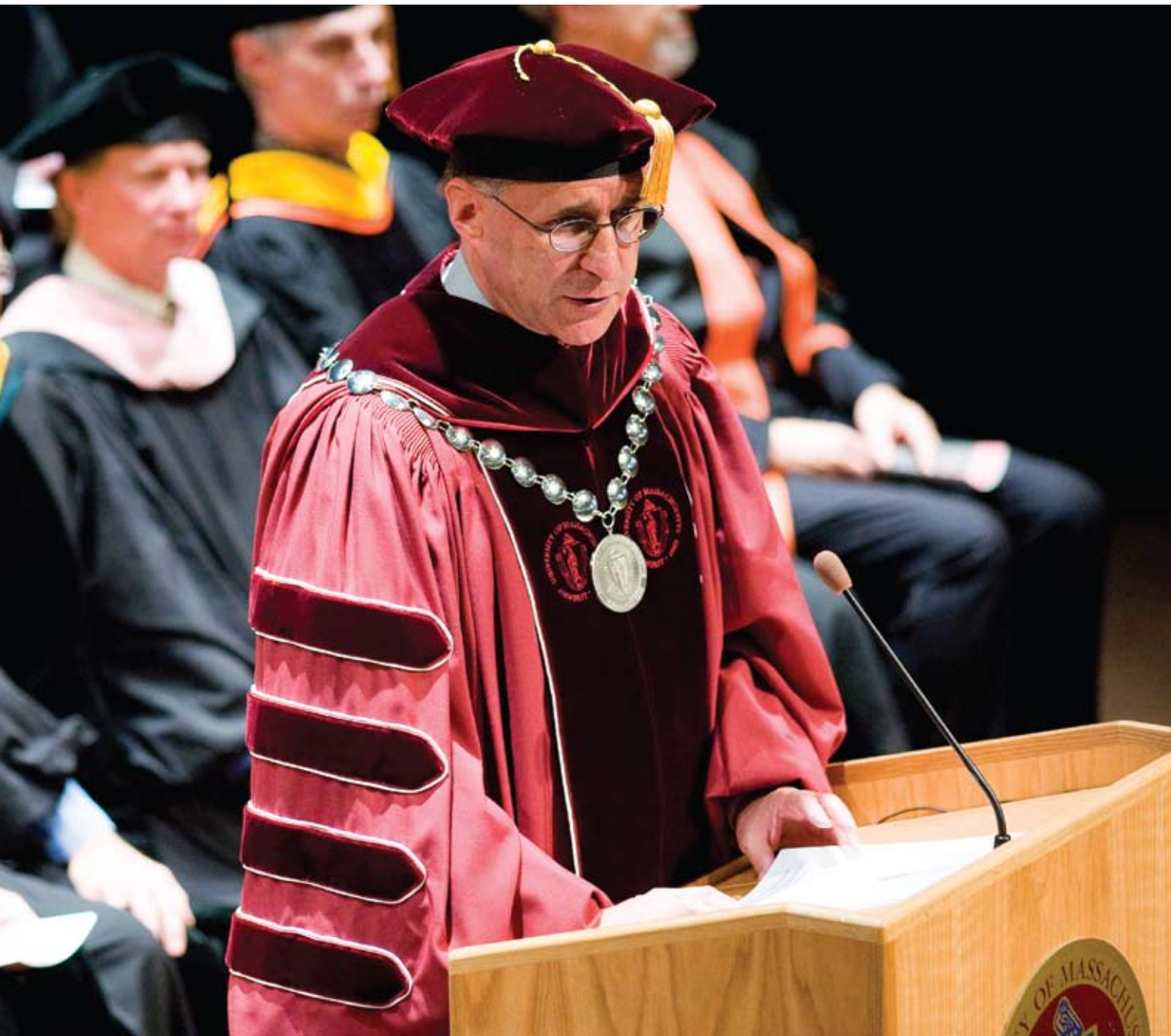


Commitment

"I remember my lower-middle-class roots and recognize the contribution of UMass Amherst in building my career as a successful businessman. I have made a commitment to giving others the opportunity I've had. That commitment extends to creating endowed professorships, awarding scholarships, and making gifts for bricks and mortar on campus."

Eugene Isenberg '50, '00Hon., president of the UMass Amherst Foundation, is chairman and chief executive officer of Nabors Industries Ltd. His giving totals \$9 million and is earmarked for endowed professorships, scholarships, and the School of Management that bears his name. This year, the 100th Isenberg Scholarship was awarded.





In Chancellor Holub's first official address to the campus, he outlined his vision for UMass Amherst:

On my first day walking to work at UMass Amherst, I found myself confronted by a ditch. Undaunted (and also ignorant of other routes to my office in the Whitmore Administration Building), I took a few steps back and leapt from the precipice, across the abyss, to safety on the other side.

This ditch, no matter the angst it caused me on my first day, is a necessary part of improving the campus. Indeed, any campus that does not have cranes, construction crews, mud, and open ditches is moribund and unprepared for the future.

Becoming a premier public research university is not easy, and when I broached the topic during my first few months, I was occasionally met with skepticism, such as the system does not give us enough funding, or we are too far from the center of things in Boston, or the politicians customarily ignore the flagship. Still others regard the deprecation of higher education in the Commonwealth as an insurmountable barrier.

My response is that we must leave the past behind. These are facts, and, contrary to some opinions, they are not uniformly disadvantageous to us. We must seek to use our location and our constitution as a flagship to our best advantage.

Emblematic of what we must do and the spirit we must regain is the crew team from our campus that competed in July of 1871 in a regatta against the purportedly superior squads from Harvard and Brown. Our entry engaged in a fierce training regime, overcame enormous odds, ultimately scoring a major upset, and, in doing so, established a new record time for the course. Evidently the president of our ancestor institution, William Smith Clark, was so excited about the victory that he plunged into the Connecticut River to greet the triumphant crew. Later he drove his team of horses back to campus in a frenzy to announce the astounding news.

The spirit and determination of those young men is what we must recapture as a collective if we are going to be successful in our aspirations. Like a crew team, we must act in a coordinated fashion, all pulling in the same direction with identical purpose. My words and direction may assist us, but only with the activities of the entire campus and its many friends can we achieve our desired place among the finest public institutions of higher education.

When that day arrives, I will be delighted to celebrate our collective triumph with a dip in the Connecticut River and an announcement to the campus from atop a frenzied stallion. I might even try to jump that ditch on horseback.

Adele Jean '12

High School: Boston Latin School

Major: "I've long been interested in public service so I am majoring in political science and plan to attend law school." Adele's public service career is already impressive. At Boston Latin, where she enrolled as a seventh-grader, she was an active member of the Caribbean Club and Student Council, served as a tutor for the Saturday Success School, volunteered in the library, and led tours of the campus.

The Award's Significance: "It felt like my hard work at Boston Latin was noticed and appreciated."

Proud Moment: "I'm the first in my family to attend college."

Words for the Topols: "This is an honor and I am truly thankful."

Bottom Line: For 18-year-old Adele, the scholarship means she won't have to take a work-study job, so can focus more time on academics. "And for my parents, it takes a load off their shoulders."

Thanks to **Sidney Topol '47** and his wife, **Lillian**, every year for the next four years, five students, including Adele Jean '12, will receive \$5,000 scholarships to study one of the natural sciences. The Sidney & Lillian Topol Scholarship Fund for Diversity is open to students from Boston who demonstrate financial need and represent a group that has been historically underrepresented in higher education. "I have a long history of trying to improve race relations," says Sidney Topol, a leader in the telecommunications industry. "It just seems right that I help. I'm an American success story. I grew up in a family with modest means."

Joan Barksdale '66, an alumna of the Department of Mathematics and Statistics, together with her husband, **Edgar**, established a fund with a commitment of \$108,000 to benefit students in the College of Natural Sciences and Mathematics. The fund will provide support to five first-year undergraduate students planning to major in natural sciences, with preference for students majoring in mathematics and interested in teaching. "Giving an opportunity to someone who is diligent and gifted is a privilege for us," says Joan. "We've been blessed financially, and we want to help others achieve their goals and dreams."

Graduate students teaching in the UMass Amherst writing program, which helps undergraduates sharpen their writing skills, will benefit from a gift from **Charles Moran**, professor emeritus of English, and his wife, **Kay Moran**, a writer. They gave \$25,000 to the Charles and Kay Moran Graduate Fellowship in Composition and Rhetoric. The fellowship's purpose is to help recruit and retain gifted graduate students. Since it was established in 2001, the year Charles retired, the fellowship fund has grown: "More than a hundred people have given to it," he says proudly, "and they keep giving, sending in checks large and small."

Peter '78 and Denise Bloom '79 have given \$25,000 to the Kenneth L. O'Brien scholarship. This scholarship honors track and field coach O'Brien and is being awarded to Commonwealth College students who participate in an intercollegiate, non-revenue Olympic sport, with preference given to cross-country and track-and-field athletes.

Group President of Procter & Gamble, North America, **Edward Shirley '78**, created a merit scholarship for Isenberg School of Management undergraduates who have challenged themselves through international travel, internships, and other extra-curricular learning activities. His pledge of \$100,000 will receive a partial match from P&G's matching gift program.

Robert Brack '60, an alumnus of the College of Engineering, has established the Robert Barker Brack Post-Doctoral Fellowship for civil and environmental engineering research with a gift of \$100,000, and also gave an additional \$50,000 to the Brack Scholarship for Civil and Environmental Engineering.

Campus friends **John C. and Elaine F. Brouillard** continue to grow the Brouillard Scholarship Endowment they established in 2005 with this year's pledge of \$137,500. The fund assists undergraduates in the College of Engineering who hail from Cape Cod, Martha's Vineyard, or Nantucket.

Paying Attention to Language Acquisition

Lisa Sanders' introduction to neuroscience came when she was taking an undergraduate psychology course at Rice University. The professor brought in a human brain, and Sanders was hooked. Now she is director of the Neurocognition and Perception Laboratory at UMass Amherst.

This spring the John Merck Fund awarded Sanders a \$300,000 grant to research a possible correlation between attention deficit disorders and language acquisition problems. Sanders, who joined the faculty of the psychology department in 2005, was one of two researchers in the country to receive the John Merck Scholars Program grant, the purpose of which is "to encourage exceptional young individuals to focus on the problems of children who are mentally challenged and emotionally disturbed."

According to Sanders, there has been relatively little investigation into whether there is a causal relationship between attention problems and language acquisition problems—and what precisely the relationship is. "When

a child is learning language, any number of things can go wrong," she says. A child might not hear well or be able to process what he or she hears effectively. Sanders will try to determine if attention deficit is also an obstacle and to find ways to overcome it.

This fall, Sanders' lab will start testing young children, 60 or so altogether. Without the Merck grant to cover the study's expenses, she believes, she probably would have had to wait 10 years to pursue this research. Among her team members will be four to eight undergrads. Sanders knows firsthand how valuable the experience can be for undergrads: "There's always something going on in the lab, and they learn how to help each other out and be part of a team."

From her four-year study, Sanders wants to find ways to help children learn language by improving their attentiveness. "The goal is to make the resources we develop as freely available as possible," she says, to parents, teachers, counselors, and programs such as Head Start. "That might be through a Website, for instance, with specific activities a parent could do with a child."

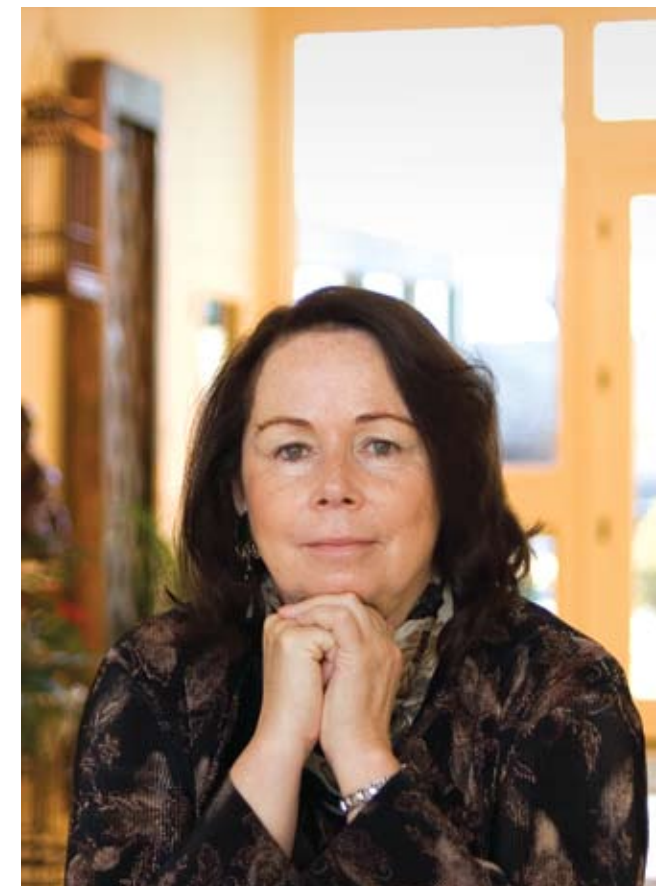

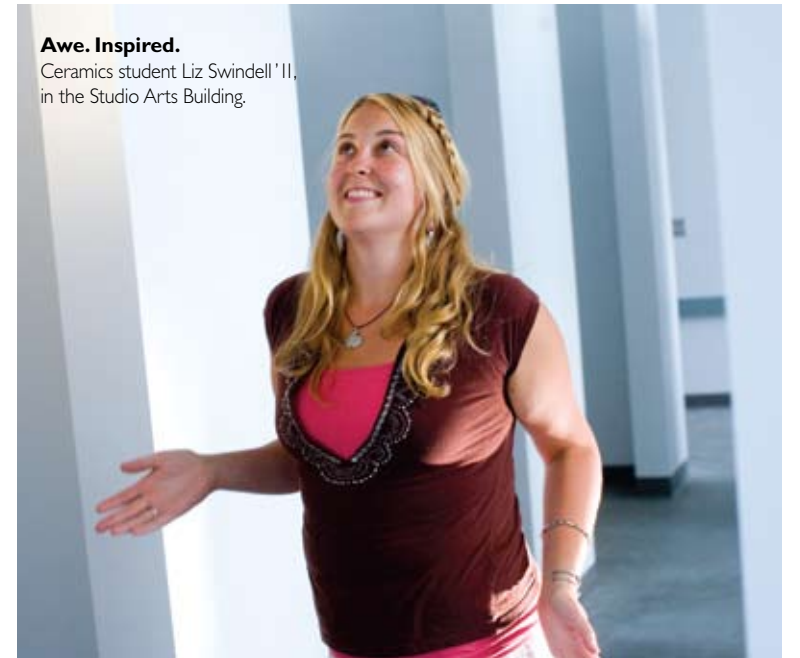
Housing Ambitions



Meredith Richardson '58 was class officer her freshman and sophomore years, then she married and completed her senior year in absentia. As her class's 50th reunion approached, she wanted to get "more reconnected," went to a planning meeting, and the next thing she knew, was Class Gift committee chair. "There were a lot of worthy causes on campus," she says, to which the gift might go, but in the end the patio in front of the new Studio Arts Building won out. "The idea of giving to a new building, at one of the gateways to the campus, was exciting," Richardson says, and the more she learned about the building, the more exciting it became.

World renowned artist **Shan Shan Sheng '87MFA** donated an installation called, "Leaves, Sky, Water" that adorns the Commons in the second-floor atrium. Her artworks have been installed in four of the world's tallest buildings. The UMass Amherst gift has a value of more than \$100,000.

At the dedication of the Class of 1958 Patio during Reunion Weekend, art department chair **Bill Oedell** talked about the building's innovative design. The ventilating system, for instance, is customized to handle the requirements of each art form in each studio. Richardson thinks that's terrific and also loves the way that "the first-floor studios can open up and the students can go out and take their artwork with them." Of the Class of '58 patio, she says, "It's a focal point. It can be used by everyone—students, people from other parts of the campus, children of the staff, the community. When I go back and visit, I know I'll be very proud to have been a part of creating it."

Two years in the making, the Studio Arts Building is now open, and students and faculty are getting down to work in classrooms and studios. Made of sustainable materials and making the most of natural light, the V-shaped structure is one of the greenest on campus. Its handsome design, by the noted architectural firm Gund Partnership, combines traditional and contemporary elements, with the centerpiece being a dramatic glass atrium. Within its two wings are customized classrooms, a student commons, and a gallery. Patio workspaces and a courtyard extend the creativity into the outdoors.

Ceramics major **Liz Swindell '11** is enjoying her senior year in the new building. From a Topsfield family of farmers, she loves ceramics for that "relationship to clay," she says. "I make functional vessels, teapots, and tiles. I also try to practice what I preach: live simply and be aware, so I do a lot of

recycling. I take other students' failed pots and re-use the clay, and I make mosaics from broken pots."

Last spring, Swindell got a head-start bonding with the building, helping with moving and setting up the ceramics room. Among the benefits of the new place, she says, is new equipment like the pug mill, which extracts air from clay. The mill replaces a manual method that was much more laborious and messy, Swindell admits.

What most excites her about the new building, though, is not the facility itself but what happens inside (and, in nice weather, outside) its walls: "It's the combining of people from different concentrations. Up to now I haven't had contact with artists in other disciplines. There will be a lot of creative energy swimming around in there, the chance for discussions and to bounce ideas off one another."

Leadership



After the first time Professor **Richard Simpson '58** taught an accounting class, he asked a fellow grad student, "Can you believe they're paying us to do this? I'd do it for nothing."

Forty-one years at UMass Amherst have not dimmed his enthusiasm for his subject or for teaching. "There are still a lot of first-generation students who come here, and it means so much to them, and they work like hell," he says. "Good students like to work hard, and if that's your goal, I'm your guy."

A member of the Isenberg School of Management faculty, Simpson received the University Distinguished Teaching Award in 1983, the University Outstanding Teaching Award in 2001, and the Alumni Association's Distinguished Faculty Member Award in 2003. Now he is being honored again, with the endowment of a professorship bearing his name. Simpson says he was "overjoyed and almost speechless" when he found out about the Professor Richard H. Simpson Endowed Professorship. Fundraising has brought in nearly \$1 million

in gifts from 160 ISOM alumni, including lead gifts from **John N. Spinney Jr. '87** and **Joseph J. Floyd '83**, as well as matching gifts from the Big Four accounting firms.

Simpson's students learn through solving accounting problems he gives them, along with some 900 pages worth of handouts a semester. He encourages them to think critically. "The field changes constantly. When there's a new rule, I like to tear into it and figure out what it means. I ask my students, 'Is this change good? Will it make financial statements harder to understand?' ... I like a lot of interaction, it's easier to teach that way. If they get something wrong, that's even better. When students make a mistake and work through it, you know they won't ever make that mistake again."

When he stands before a class and "nothing comes out," he says, "I'll quit that day." Through the summer, he notes, "teaching is such a solitary thing. My wife calls me 'the hermit in the basement.' But then the students come back." And nothing is better than that.



Judith H. Katz '74MED, '76 EdD, vice president of Kaliell Jamison Consulting Group, Inc., made a lead gift to the School of Education Centennial Fund, which will support innovative faculty and graduate student teaching and research projects that might not be funded through existing grants and contracts. Examples of areas that need private support are programs that promote equity and access in education for students of traditionally underrepresented groups, community service learning courses that build bridges between prospective teachers and local urban and rural communities, and initiatives that expand students' global awareness through the use of technology.

Elaine Linscott '62 has endowed the Elaine Linscott School of Nursing Professional Development Award for a faculty member enrolled in a doctoral program that will enhance his or her scholarship and teaching.



The Art of Philanthropy



With a pledge of \$360,000, **Ronald Ansin '96** has established the Ronald M. Ansin Study Abroad Fellows Fund. The fund supports students enrolled in the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences to participate in study-abroad programs around the world.



Russell W. Yarworth '78, '84MS, UMass Men's Swim Team head coach, remembers former team member **James P. Robertson Jr. '92** as "a reluctant student" but also as someone "who clearly had a gift as a people person." Robertson persevered in his studies and in the "grind-it-out" sport, as Yarworth calls it, and is now a successful Boston real estate developer. Robertson's gifts of more than \$60,000 to support the swim team represent his desire to help out a coach who once helped him. Robertson and his friend and classmate **John L. Gardiner, Jr. '90**, says Yarworth, told him, "You've been doing fundraising for 30 years. Now it's time for us to take it on."

Under Yarworth's leadership, the men's swimming and diving team has won 10 Atlantic 10 titles, the most in league history, and eight consecutive New England championships. Travel and equipment expenses are high for a winning team. Swimmers need more than Speedos: now de rigueur are full body suits, which cost between \$300 and \$400 and wear out after about two championship meets. Beyond covering these costs, Yarworth would like to increase the scholarship endowment.



Cultivating Conversations

Landscape professor emeritus **Julius Fábos** has been writing his memoirs. Generations of his family farmed in Hungary, tending their fields, vineyards, and orchards of pear, cherry, apple, and plum trees. Then came World War II, and the postwar Communist government, which imprisoned Fábos's beloved father and sent the young Julius Fábos, then an agronomy student, first to a slave labor camp, then to work in a coal mine. Eventually he escaped to the United States, graduated from Harvard, and came to UMass Amherst.

Fábos has been credited with no less than defining, with Ian McHarg, "the field of landscape assessment and planning." He pioneered the idea of the "greenway," and during his years as director of the UMass Amherst graduate program in landscape architecture oversaw the studies of 100-plus graduate students. His expertise led to consulting work and from there, he says, "Real estate development became my hobby."



Having realized enough from those investments to provide for his family's future, Fábos donated some of his property to UMass Amherst. "How many steaks can you eat in a day?" he asks wryly, then answers his own question: "None, if you want to stay healthy."

The proceeds from the sale of the two condominiums he has given will endow an exchange program between UMass Amherst and Corvinus University of Budapest. The Julius Gyula and Edith Fábos Endowment will build on a relationship between the landscape planning departments of both schools that Fábos has been fostering for several years. As Fábos sees it, by endowing the fund, he is giving to his homeland and helping UMass Amherst's landscape architecture department. Of his field, Fábos

says, "Only good things come out of landscape architecture." Through the fund, those committed to landscape architecture will be "talking to each other, making connections, and making friendships"—all good things.

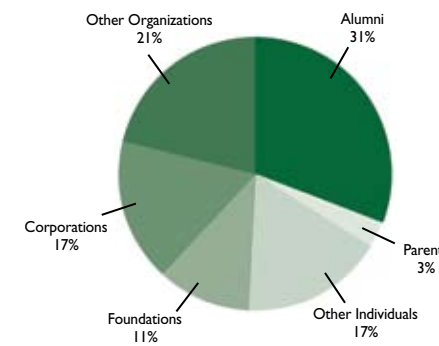

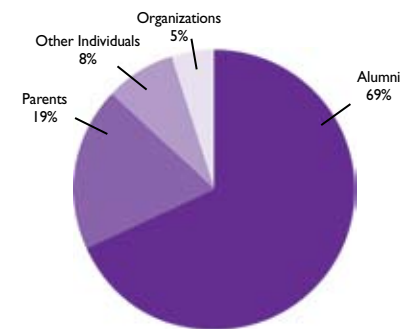

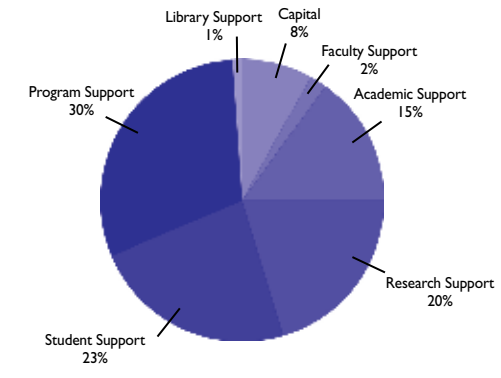
By Constituency



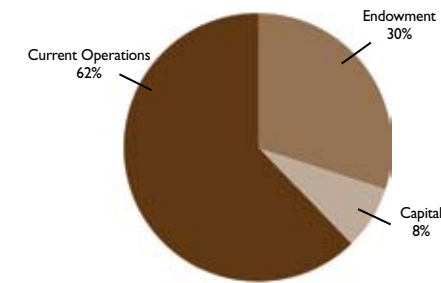
Number of Donors by Constituency

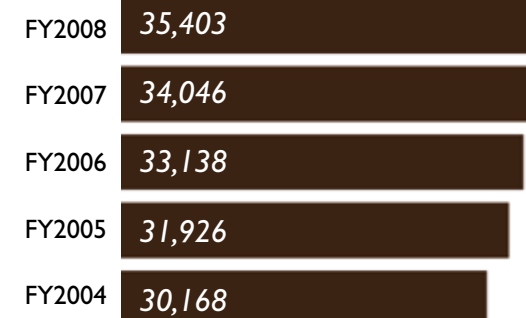

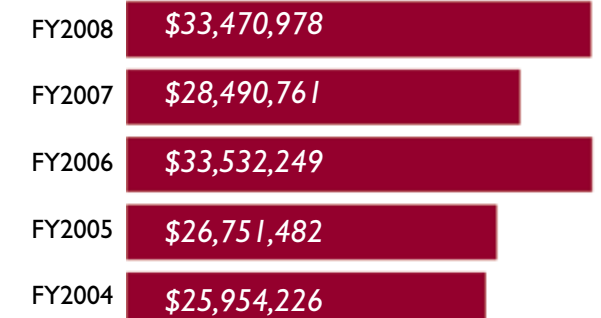
